### Secretary's Report:

### Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Sabrina A. presented report. Jim C. brought up a question regarding the Area trip. The total balance per bank statement is reported at \$3,045.03. The prudent reserve is \$1,989.54. James motions to approve report. Motion is seconded by Greg. Motion passes.

### DCM Report:

Richard S. reports that the CPC and PI Area representatives are traveling to Tallahassee for the August 27 workshop. The Delegate's Report workshop will be held September 17.

### Alt. DCM Report:

Jim C. reports that he attended the Intergroup5 meeting of August 2, 2017. There was sparse attendance. The holiday party will be held on December 17. They had a deficit. They pay \$287 monthly for rent. There is concern about the financial health of IG5, but Jim reassures that there is nothing to worry about. Literature sales are doing well. There were 355 calls to the hotline in July. Greg interjects to say that IG5 is looking for a new activities chair. They have \$7500 in checking and \$4000 in prudent reserve.

- *Men's Faith Group*. James R. reports things are going well. There are 40-50 guys normally every Thursday night from 8-9 p.m. His group took up a collection of \$200 for the shortfall at the General Service Office.
- *Came to Believe*: Rose reports that the group is in great shape.
- *Lloyd New Hope Group*: Greg reports that his group has steady attendance, yet Fridays seem to be harder to get folks through the door. They will be celebrating 41 years of sobriety.
- *Southside*: Al reports that his groups meets 6 nights a week. Attendance has been slow throughout the summer. Dinner is held every Saturday at 6:30 and meeting to follow at 8.
